



# Off-Site Attendance Reporting System

## The Challenge

Providing off-site employees the means to report attendance, start, and-end of work-day, while protecting their employment contracts and right for breaks.

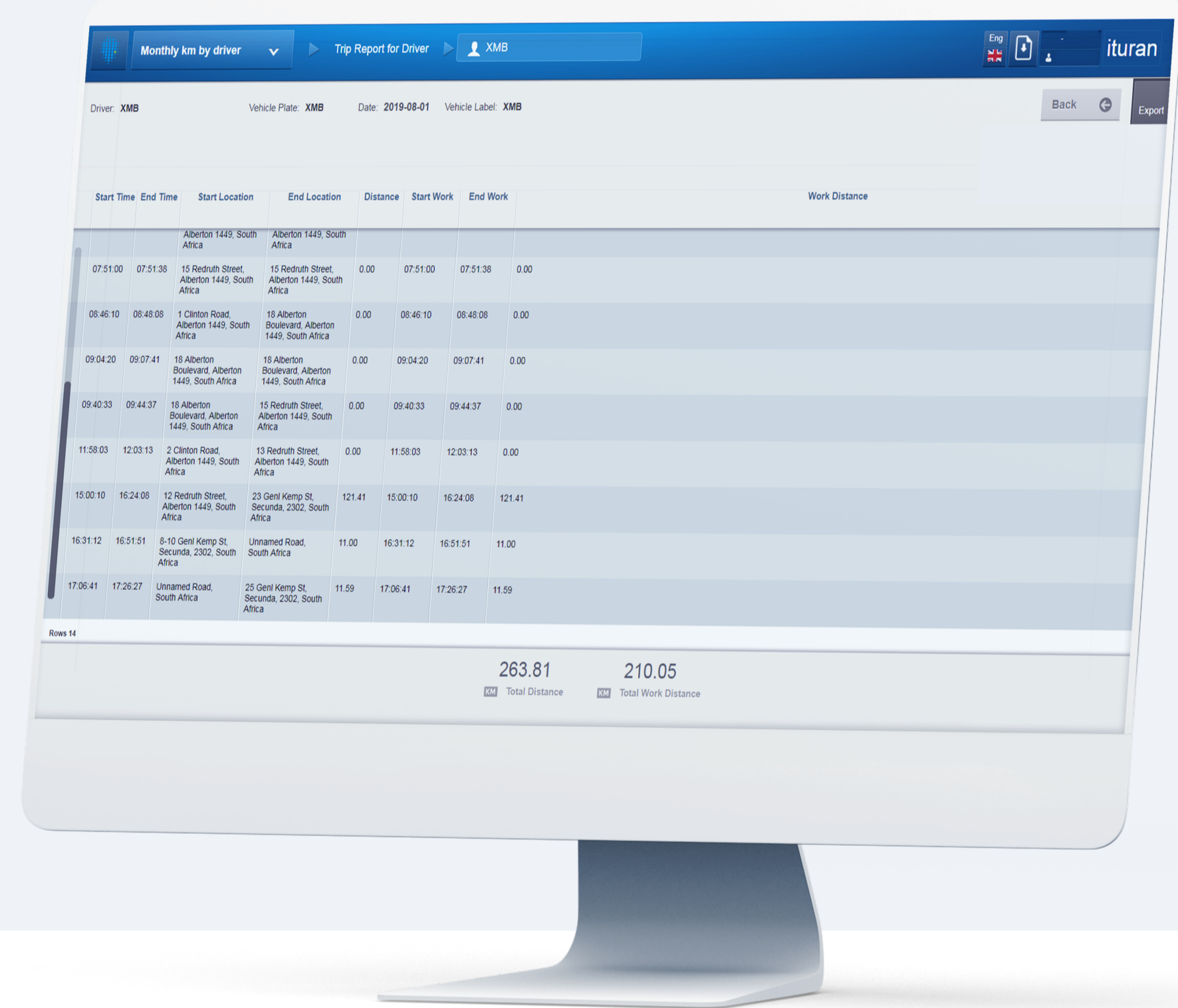
## Our Solution

An in-vehicle reporting system that allows off-site employees (driver and crew) to easily report the beginning and end of their work-day, from a panel installed on the dashboard of company-owned vehicles. The time-stamp generated by the system also includes the exact location of employee at check-in and out.

Employee identification can be done using a magnetic card / Keypad or Dallas Key. The system also makes sure that break-time and working hours are in accordance with employee contract and the law. Data can be transmitted into the company's payroll software.

## The Saving

Using a reliable and convenient attendance reporting systems to streamline the process guarantees that the payroll department receives data on off-site employees in a similar manner to on-site employees, eliminating the need to chase after individual reports. It saves time, potential conflict, and allows management to easily supervise off-site teams.



## Main Features

- An easy-to-use mechanism to report attendance of any employee in the organization, using a dedicated component
- Driver Identification through Keypad / Magnetic card / Dallas Key
- Data including the location at check-in/out which is saved in the fleet management system, can be retrieved at any time and used in reports
- Easy interface to payroll software

## System Components

- Starlink GPS/GPRS location identifier installed in vehicle
- Fleet management software with web interface and application
- Reporting panel installed near driver's seat
- Secure cloud-based data collection and reporting of Car log data
